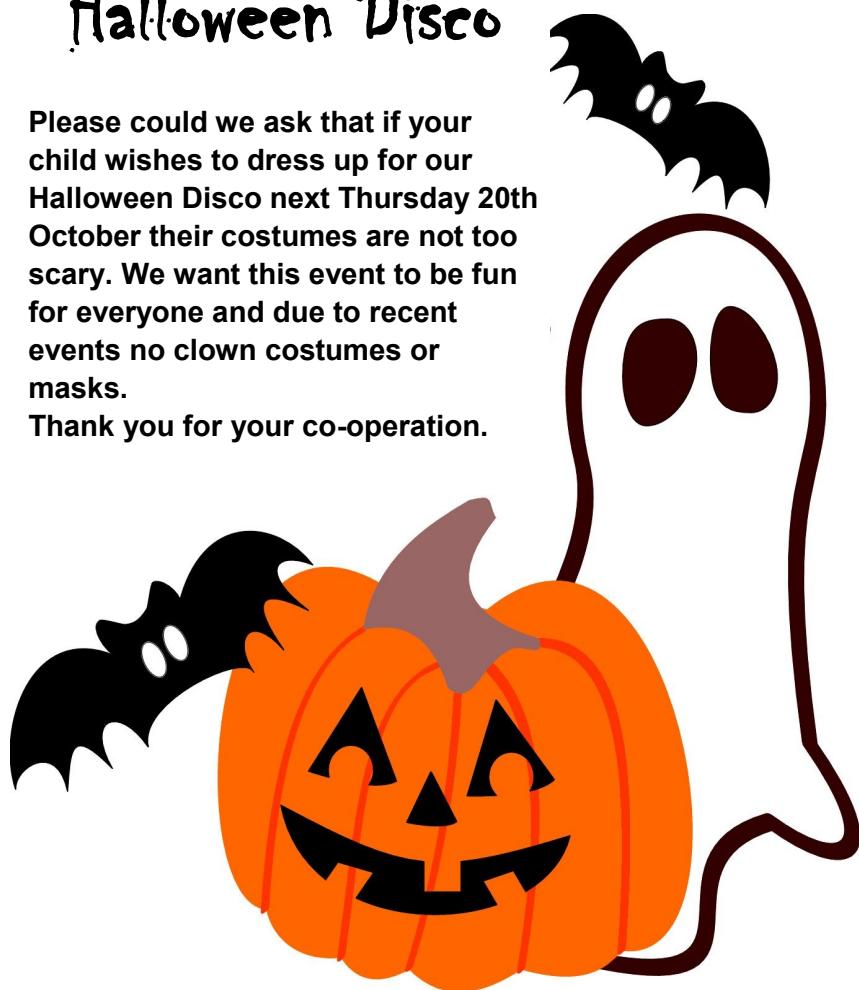












Halloween Disco
